This type of project – the successor to Tempus, Alfa and Edulink – is new in the 2015 Call.
- **Jean Monnet** activities with the aim of stimulating teaching, research and reflection in the field of European Union studies worldwide (deadline for applying: 26 February 2015).

You may receive queries from your ministries, universities or students in your countries about the opportunities offered by the programme. For this reason we are e-mailing you with this note a short guide to the Programme, with some guidance on how to field these questions, and guide people to the right source of information on how to get involved.

Subject: Publication of the 2015 Erasmus+ General Call for proposals

Dear Colleagues,

I am pleased to inform you that the 2015 Erasmus+ General Call for proposals was published on 2 October. The call and the updated Erasmus+ Programme Guide are available at the following address:

Erasmus+ includes a strong international dimension (i.e. cooperation with Partner Countries) notably in the field of higher education.

In this respect Erasmus+ supports the following actions targeting cooperation with Partner Countries, two of which are being launched for the first time this year, with the availability of budget from external funding instruments. The exception is for ACP countries, where the funding under EDF will come on line in the next Call, for selection in 2016):

- **International credit mobility of students and staff and Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees (under Key Action 1) promoting the mobility of learners and staff to and from Partner Countries (deadline for applying: 4 March 2015). This is new in the 2015 Call;**

¹ Programme countries are the EU 28 + Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Turkey and the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, i.e. all countries that contribute financially to the programme and have a National Agency to manage it. Partner Countries are all other countries throughout the world.
